Coimbatore Institute of Technology was founded in the year 1956 by V. Rangaswamy Naidu Educational Trust (VRET) with the noble aim of disseminating knowledge in the fields of science, engineering and technology to the student community.

The philanthropic founders envisioned a unique professional learning order with special emphasis on industrial training. CIT was affiliated to Madras University from 1956 to 1980. In the year 1980, the Institute got affiliated to Bharathiar University and subsequently to Anna University in 2001. CIT is a Government-aided institution, recognized by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

CIT offers 7 Under Graduate Academic Programmes, 9 Post Graduate Academic Programmes, 3 Five Year Integrated M.Sc. Programmes in addition to Ph.D. Research Programmes. As part of the invaluable service rendered to the society by V. Rangaswamy Educational Trust, the CIT Sandwich Polytechnic College was started in 1961. Presently, 8 Engineering Diploma Programmes are offered by the polytechnic in various engineering disciplines.

## AUTONOMOUS STATUS OF THE INSTITUTE & INFORMATION FOR AFFILIATING UNIVERSITY

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Coimbatore Institute of Technology is an Autonomous Institution currently affiliated to Anna University. The Institute has been accorded Autonomous Status by the University Grants Commission since 1987. Current Autonomous is valid upto May 2020 and applied for extension of autonomous status.

The Institute has set up statutory bodies such as Governing Council, Academic Council, Finance Committee, Board of studies and Non-statutory bodies like Planning and Evaluation Committee, Library Committee, Curriculum Development cell, Examination Disciplinary Committee, Result Passing Board etc., for effective functioning of Autonomous system. Office of the Controller of Examinations administered by Dr.R.Sriram, Controller of Examinations, Dr.R.Sathyanarayan Sridhar, Deputy Controller of Examinations and assisted by thirteen well-qualified and experienced staff facilitates the efficient functioning of the Autonomous System.

- ◆ Autonomous Status has created an excellent opportunity to revise, redesign or introduce innovations in the curriculum. A thorough revision of syllabi in every 4 years, or whenever necessary, and introduction of elective courses as and when required to suit the needs of industry have helped the students to keep abreast of the latest trends in the industry, especially in the IT sector.
- ◆ Continuous assessment in laboratory practicals, workshop practice and engineering drawing has been introduced under the Autonomous scheme since 2001. This has inculcated a sense of responsibility and regularity among the students. Continuous assessment of the students academic performance makes the evaluation process more objective and complete. The scheme of continuous evaluation has been proved to be a great success.
- ◆ Students are given the option to study German / French language as an alternative to English in the II semester of their study after joining the Institute.
- ◆ Four week of Industrial training is compulsory for the students to become eligible for the award of degree by the University. This is in practice since 2009.
- ◆ A mini project of 2 credits is offered to the students of V and VI semester.
- ◆ Credit system has been introduced to all the programmes since 2001.
- ◆ For assessment, grades are awarded instead of marks. This has made the evaluation process more realistic.
- ◆ Choice Based Credit System has been followed from 2015.
- ◆ All the question papers for U.G. programmes are set by external / internal examiners and valuation is done both by Internal and external examiners. The procedure adopted ensures objective evaluation of student's performance in the examination.
- ◆ Complete Autonomy is given for the conduct of PG programmes. Setting of question papers and valuation of answer scripts are done internally. This gives more freedom and flexibility to the teacher at P.G. level.

- ◆ Conduct of examination, publication of results and issue of grade sheets are done systematically and with a fixed time frame. This has enabled the students to apply for employment / higher studies on time.
- ◆ Introduction of transparency in the valuation of answer scripts has instilled confidence among students in the examination system under autonomous scheme. The students have the option to go through their valued answer scripts accompanied by another student / teacher of their choice and apply for revaluation if they desire.
- ◆ A special supplementary examination is conducted for students of outgoing batches who have arrears in the final semester.
- ◆ For character building and overall development of the students, not only as a competent engineer, but also as a responsible citizen of the country, a course called Science of Creativity and Professional Ethics has been introduced since the inception of the Autonomous scheme in the year 1987

## GOVERNANCE OF THE INSTITUTION

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The Institute is governed by the governing council composed as per guidelines laid down by UGC and AICTE.

The Governing Council is responsible to determine the future direction, oversee the Institution activities and foster an environment in which the mission and vision of the Institution are achieved. The responsibility includes considering and approving the strategic plan of the Institute. The strategic plans set out the academic aims and objectives of the Institution and identify the financial, physical and staffing requirements to achieve these objectives. The Council oversees the creation and delivery of the strategic vision consistent with the mission of the institution. At the Institute level, a team comprising the Head of the Institution, Heads of the departments and senior faculty members shall formulate a draft strategic plan. This is discussed and approved by the governing council with suitable modifications if found necessary. The strategic plan is reviewed after three years

The Governing Council shall ensure that there exists a clear and well established audit procedure for all the financial aspects of the Institution. The Council is responsible to monitor performance of the Institution against plans and approved key performance indicators which are appropriately bench marked.

The Council is responsible to appoint the Head of the Institution as per guidelines stipulated by Government of Tamilnadu and AICTE.

Based on the recommendation of the Principal, Council appoints suitable faculty mentors to the following positions:

- ◆ Deans
- ◆ Administrative Officer
- ◆ Heads of Departments
- ◆ Controller of Examinations

The Council reviews the performance of managerial / administrative positions in the Institute periodically.

The Council discusses the implementation of proposals considered earlier and seeks explanation from the Principal regarding the lapses if any.

The Council studies the performance of the students in the examinations and suggests ways and means to improve the performance of the students in future.

The Council reviews the placements activities in the preceding academic year and makes suggestions to improve employment opportunities for the students.

The Council ensures that a policy is in place regarding human resources development and employment in the Institution as per AICTE / State Government norms.

The Governing Council initiates activities to create and support global national and local collaborations between Institution and academic partners, research and industry who support the mission and objectives of the institution.

Based on the recommendation of the Academic Council, the Governing Council approves the Institution of scholarships, fellowships, medals, prizes and certificates.

The Council considers and approves the request of the Institution to start new programmes of study leading to degree / diploma



The Department of Library, Coimbatore Institute of Technology was established in 1956. It is located next to the Academic Block of CIT, in a vast area of 12160 sq.ft. (1302 sq. m.). The main objective of CIT library is to provide information services and access to print and e-resources to support the scholarly and informational needs of the institute's vibrant student community. The fully computerized library is well equipped with modern facilities and resources in the form of books, print and electronic journals, CD-ROMs and on-line databases, etc. 'Open Access' system is being followed in the library.

## OVERDUE CHARGES

The borrowed book may be renewed for one more period, if no one has reserved the same. If a borrowed book or other material is not returned / renewed within the due date of return, an overdue charge of Rs. 0.50 per day will be charged.

When obtaining the 'clearance certificate' from the library, students have to pay the overdue charges pending in their account at the end of each semester.

## LOSS OF BOOKS

If a borrowed book is lost or damaged, the borrower is required to replace the same edition or the latest edition of the same book. If it is not done so, triple the cost of the latest edition of the book has to be remitted.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Complete silence is to be observed in the library.
- Usage of cell phone is totally prohibited inside the library.
- Users must keep their belongings at the “Property Counter” before entering the library.
- However, they are advised not to leave valuables like mobile, calculator, purse, etc.
- Users must scan the bar-code of their ID card in the system kept at the entrance while entry/exit to record their visit to the library.
- Users have to produce their bar-coded membership card to the library staff on demand.
- Users should leave the books and journals on the table after reading.
- Misplacement of books in different shelves is punishable.
- Underlining, scribbling and / or tearing of pages or any other type of mutilation of books and journals, mishandling or misuse of computers is punishable.
- If any book / journal is brought out of the library without proper entry, serious action will be taken.
- The competent authority will take necessary action against the users who violate the library systems and services.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in the above rules, the decision of the authorities of the Institute in all matters related to the library services and usage shall be final and binding on all users.

## Computing Facilities

The institute has state of the art computing facilities which include CAD/CAM lab, Computer Based Process Control, CFD Lab, Robotics and Cloud Computing Lab. Each department has a separate computer centre. The Computer facilities are used to the maximum extent to impart high quality training to Under Graduate and Post Graduate students and for research purposes. All the centres have internet access. There is also a separate CAD centre for Training & Consultancy franchised by Autodesk, California, USA.

## Internet

Internet facility with a bandwidth of 170 Mbps is available. Internet centre is kept open on all days with 60 seating capacity. Internet facility is also available in all the computer centres in the departments.

## Other Facilities

### Science of Creativity and Personality Development

A subject named "Science of Creativity and Personality Development" was introduced from the academic year 1988-89 for the students to maintain a sound physique and imbibe intellectual and moral values.

The following are the salient features of the new subject :

- Philosophy and purpose of life.
- Knowledge of the interaction among individuals, society and the world.

### Counselling System

Each student is assigned to the care of a faculty member called Tutor, who will be available for consultation and advice on all matters, academic and social. Tutor-Ward Meetings (TWM's) are held every week. The students are expected to meet the assigned tutors and discuss the progress and problems in studies and extra-curricular activities. All leave letters and other correspondence to the authorities should be forwarded through the tutors only. Class council meetings discuss the progress of the classes during the semester.

### Intensive Coaching Scheme

Weekly tests and assignments form part of this intensive coaching scheme. The academic progress and the attendance of the students are reviewed periodically. In addition, two mid-semester tests are conducted during each semester. Sessional marks are awarded on the basis of the performance in these tests, attendance and assignments.

### Medical Facilities

There is a Dispensary in the campus with a full-time Pharmacist. He is in charge of all the routine medical requirements. An experienced medical practitioner of the cadre of Civil Surgeon is attached to the Institute. He visits the Institute every Thursday and looks after the medical needs of the students. All students are required to undergo medical check-up every year.

### Physical Education Facilities

Facilities are available for playing the games in the Institute namely: Cricket, Basket Ball, Foot Ball, Volley Ball, Hockey, Tennis & Tennis. Besides, there is a big stadium with a 400 metre track for all the athletic events. Provisions are available for special training in gymnastics and body-building. A course in Karate is conducted at the Institute.

A Physical Director assisted by a Physical Training Instructor looks after the athletic activities. Every year internal tournaments are conducted, so as to enable the students to take active part in the games. Further, the Institute enters the Inter-Collegiate League and

Knockout Tournaments of the Coimbatore Inter-Collegiate Athletic Association and also the tournaments and sports conducted by the Coimbatore District Sports Club and Anna University.

### **National Cadet Corps - NCC**

Participation in NCC is on voluntary basis. Once a student joins NCC, he must continue to be on the roll for a minimum period of 3 years. The Institute has an Army Technical Wing. A Signal Platoon attached to the 2(TN) Composite Technical Company named 2/2 Signal Platoon with an allotted strength of 62 Cadets is functioning in the Institute. Training is imparted to the cadets for a period of three years. During the first year, the cadets are taught basic military Subjects like Drill (with and without arms), Weapon's Training, Map Reading, Field Training, Civil Defence, First Aid, Military History and Military Geography, Traffic Control Duties, Organisation of Armed Forces, etc. During the second and third year, the cadets are trained in the technical subjects like R.T. Procedure, Wireless Equipment, Line Equipment, Construction and Maintenance of Line, Charging Set, Organisation of LBde, and Div, Sigs, etc.

All the NCC cadets undergo a combined Annual Training Camp lasting for a period of 10 days. Meritorious Cadets attend "All India Summer Training Camp", "Attachment Camp to Regular Army Units", Mountaineering Training", "Adventure Training", "National Integration Camp", etc at different centres in India.

### **National Service Scheme - NSS**

The National Service Scheme unit of the Institute has been functioning since 1977-78. There are four NSS units functioning in the Institute with 100 volunteers in each unit. They undertake community and rural development activities in and around Pachapalayam, Poorandampalayam, Molapalayam and Urumandan Gounden Pudur - the adopted villages of the Institute. These units concentrate on Adult Education Programmes, Health and Hygiene Campaigns etc. In addition to regular activities, summer camps are also conducted.

### **Youth Red Cross - YRC**

The Youth Red Cross Unit of the Institute has been functioning from the Academic year 2003 - 2004.

The YRC movement is based on the following three principles:

- Protection of Health and Life
- Service to the Sick and Suffering
- Promotion of national and international friendship to develop the mental and moral capacities of the youth.

### **Placement and Training Cell**

The Institute has a Placement and Training Cell headed by a professor. The Cell interacts with leading industries, arranges for campus interviews and offers ample job opportunities to the final year students of different disciplines. Further, it takes effective steps to provide In-Plant Training to the undergraduate students with a view to prepare and acclimatize them to the industrial environment.

### Industry - Institute Partnership Cell

To act as liaison centres between industries and various departments of the Institute for activities which are mutually beneficial, an Industry Institute Partnership Cell is functioning in our Institute. It is sponsored by AICTE. The main objectives include co-ordination and promotion of consultancy services, promote sponsored and joint R&D projects, signing of MoU on behalf of the Institution and conduct training programmes for industrial personnel etc.

### Students' Union

To promote the cultural and social activities of the student body, a Students' Union is there in the Institute. The office bearers of the union are nominated by the Principal. The student who ranks first upto third year autonomous examination becomes the Chairperson of the Union and the student who ranks first upto second year examination becomes the Secretary.

Distinguished personalities from all walks of public life are invited to address the students on various topics of technical and general interest. Films of technical and social nature are often screened for the benefit of the students. The students union conducts, every year, an intramural cultural programme called 'NAKSHATRA' to tap the creative potential of the first & second year students of this Institute.

- Datalytics

All the branches of Engineering / Technology and Applied Sciences have their own associations which organise Technical Meetings, Symposia, etc. in their respective disciplines.

The Coimbatore Regional Centre of the Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers functions with its office at the Department of Chemical Engineering in the Institute.

The Coimbatore Centre of the Indian Welding Society (IWS) has been functioning in the Institute since 2002 in the Department of Mechanical Engineering.

A student branch of IEEE (USA) functions with its office at the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering in the Institute.

A student chapter of Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) functions with its office at the Dept. of CSE & IT.

### **Banking Facility**

Indian Bank, Peelamedu Branch is situated inside the Campus.

### **Auditorium**

The College has a full fledged Auditorium with a seating capacity of 1200.

### **Canteen**

The College has a canteen with a seating capacity for 200 students. It functions from 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.

## **HOSTEL**

### **Management of the Hostel**

The General Management of the Hostel shall be vested with the Principal who is also the Chief Warden. He is assisted by the Dean - Student Affairs, Deputy Warden and Counsellors. The Deputy Warden looks after the day-to-day administration of Hostel with the help of the Hostel Office.

### **Gent's Hostel**

Gent's hostels can accommodate approximately 1200 students. Students are provided with rooms for double occupancy. Facilities like indoor Pool Game room, Table Tennis, Reading Room, T.V. Room, Gymnasium and Student Store are provided. Each block is having a Residential Tutor to interact with students to improve the cordial relationship between inmates and hostel authorities.

### **Ladies Hostel**

Ladies Hostels can accommodate approximately 800 students. Four-bedded and two-bedded spacious rooms are available. Facilities like indoor Games Room, Reading Room, T.V. Room, Sick Room, Visitor's Room, Students Store, Gymnasium are provided in the hostel block. Residential Matrons take care of the welfare of students and maintenance of discipline.

### **Student Counsellors**

In order to ensure smooth running of the Hostel and to establish a healthy staff- students relationship, counsellors are appointed by the Chief Warden. The Head of Departments of the different faculties of the Institute are the Counsellors. The students belonging to a particular discipline will be directly under the care of their respective Head of the Department. The students shall seek the advice and guidance of their counsellors, whenever they are confronted with difficulties or problems.

## **Hostel Committee**

The Hostel Committee shall be constituted at the beginning of every academic year. The Committee shall consist of the following members:

- ◆ Principal & Chief Warden,
- ◆ Dean-Students Affairs,
- ◆ Deputy Wardens,
- ◆ Counsellors and Elected Representatives of the students.

The following office bearers are nominated at the beginning of the academic year.

General Secretary, Joint Secretaries, Reading Room Secretary, Mess Representatives, and TV Room Secretary

## **Duties and Responsibilities of the Members of the Hostel Committee.**

They shall assist the Warden and Deputy Warden in the following matters.

- a) Supervising the cooking and distribution of food.
- b) Preparation of the menu for the hostel mess.
- c) Ordering and purchasing of provisions for the mess.
- d) Checking the delivery of materials to ensure quality.
- e) Running the Reading Room and Library.
- f) Giving useful suggestions regarding the administration of the Hostel.
- g) To help in the maintenance of discipline in the hostel.

## **Mess and Mess Rules**

The hostel has both Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian messes. Every inmate of the hostel has to dine compulsarily in one of the two messes. These are run on dividing basis and the menu served shall be prepared and approved by the Hostel Committee. The mess month shall be reckoned from the 21st of a month to the 20th of next month.

## **Reduction Rules**

- i. Only those who will be out of station are eligible to apply for reduction. No inmate who has applied for reduction will be permitted to stay in the hostel room during the period for which reduction has been applied.
- ii. Application for reduction should be made at least two days in advance in the prescribed form available in the hostel office/with mess supervisor.

The signature of the Tutor / Faculty member authorised by the department for this purpose should be obtained in the form prescribed before submission. The reduction application form can be handed over to the mess supervisor. In addition to this, appropriate entries should be made in the reduction register available in the mess.

- iii. Reduction will be given only when the period of absence is not less than 4 days. Full reduction will be given for (n-2) days where n-refers to the number of days for which reduction has been applied.
- iv. If any inmate who has applied for mess reduction is found staying in the hostel premises during the period for which reduction is claimed, he will forfeit the reduction for the entire period.

- v. Students who have applied for reduction upto a certain period but are not able to rejoin on that date can get the period of reduction extended only by sending a letter, (seeking permission for the same) to the Deputy Warden, in advance. The students are advised to send such letters under certificate of posting.
- vi. Under no circumstances, reduction can be claimed for the lapsed period.

### **Entertainment of Guests**

- i. Members are permitted to entertain guests up to a limited number in each mess. The inmate entertaining the guest should bring his/her identity card (to establish his/her identity), make entries in the guest book in his/her own handwriting, get the duly filled in counterfoil and only then take the guest, inside the dining hall. The guest should always be accompanied by the host.
- ii. One inmate of the hostel is not permitted to entertain another inmate as guest in the mess under any circumstance.

### **Payment of Mess Charges**

Mess bill for the month ending on 20th of the calendar month will be available at the end of that calendar month. The mess bill should be paid on or before the 15th of the following calendar month. A fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be collected for payments made between the 16th and the last working day of the calendar month. If the student has not paid the mess dues before the last working day of the calendar month, the student will not be permitted to dine in the mess till the payment is made (compulsory reduction period). Further re-admission fee of Rs. 250/- will be collected. If the dues are not paid before the end of the next calendar month (end of compulsory reduction period of one month duration), the student will be deemed to have vacated from the hostel and his/her accounts will be settled by the Hostel Office automatically. Such students will not be given accommodation in the hostel. Students who default in payment of mess bills for three occasions will not be given accomodation in the hostel for subsequent years.

### **Discipline and Disciplinary Action**

Every inmate of the Hostel is expected to maintain a high standard of discipline to keep up the good name of the hostel. Inmates should refrain from antisocial activities like consuming alcoholic beverages, intoxicating drugs, etc. Indulgence in serious offences such as mentioned above may result in their expulsion from the hostel. The Deputy Wardens and Counsellors shall decide on the course of disciplinary action to be taken against students involved in such offences. A student once expelled from the Hostel shall not be eligible to seek re-admission. No inmate is allowed to entertain any expelled student in the hostel.

### **Hostel Property**

Inmates are personally responsible for the electrical fittings in their room and for the maintenance and return of the furniture assigned to them in proper condition. They will be

charged the cost of repairs for any damage done to the hostel property during the occupation of their room.

### Hostel Servants

Students should not demand any special service from Hostel servants. They should not rebuke or abuse any servant of the Hostel, but must report to the Deputy Warden any kind of misconduct or breach of duty on the part of the servants. The inmates should not pay tips to hostel servants.

### Medical Facilities

There is a Dispensary in the campus with a full-time Pharmacist. He is in charge of all the routine medical requirements. An experienced medical practitioner of the cadre of Civil Surgeon is attached to the Institute. He visits the Institute every Thursday and looks after the medical needs of the students. All students are required to undergo medical check-up every year.

### Accommodation for Guests

Normally, guests are not permitted to stay in the Hostel. However, guests with valid reasons, desirous of staying in the hostel room should get prior permission from the Deputy Warden. A nominal charge of Rs. 100/- per day will be levied for each of the guests permitted to stay in the hostel.

Separate Register for guests is maintained in the Hostel Office/Deputy Warden's Block. Proper entries should be made in the register before taking the guest to the room for their stay. No guest can stay for more than three days.

**No Female Guests are permitted under any circumstance in Gents hostel. No Male Guests are permitted under any circumstance in Ladies hostel.**

### Miscellaneous

The Warden reserves the right to put two or more students in a room.

Notices concerning the members of the Hostel shall be displayed on the Hostel Notice Boards. This shall be considered as sufficient notice to the students.

Notice of any kind other than those issued by the Warden shall require the prior approval of the Warden before they are circulated in the Hostel or put up on the Notice Board.

Any question not covered by the rules herein laid down shall be decided by the Wardens and Counsellors and duly reported to the Principal.

Environmental Engineering and Management was started in the year 2005. Post Graduate Programme in Construction Management was started in the year 2011.

The department has a team of highly experienced faculty members with rich academic and industrial experience in various frontier engineering and technology areas. The faculty members and students of the department are dedicated to work in the current needs of the industry and have the ability to improve their expertise in the field in Civil Engineering. ### Department of Mathematics

The department caters to the mathematical needs of the institute namely, it offers course for all the UG, PG and research programs, in the field of mathematics, science and humanities. ## DETAILS OF COURSES

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### **B.E. Degree**

The duration of the Course is eight semesters. The first year is directed to a course in theoretical and practical understanding of basic mathematical, scientific and technological ideas, which are common to all the branches namely Civil, Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical and Electronics, Electronics and Communication & Computer Science and Engineering. The branch allocation is done in the first year itself through counselling. Each branch specialises in its own field while imbibing broad ideas from other branches. Intensive theoretical and practical coaching is given in each branch of study. Project works are encouraged systematically and extensively to train the students to apply the theoretical knowledge to practical problems.

### **B.Tech. Degree**

- a) B.Tech. Chemical Engg.

The Course is of eight semesters duration leading to a degree in Chemical Engineering. The syllabus is both intensive and extensive with a perfect blend of topics from Unit Processes and Unit Operations considered as indispensable in many Chemical industries.

## b) B.Tech. Information Technology

The Course is of eight semesters duration leading to a degree in Information Technology.

## M.E. Degree

The Institute offers M.E. Degree Courses in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electronics & Communications Engineering and Computer Science & Engineering branches. 




