## Teaching Learning Centre

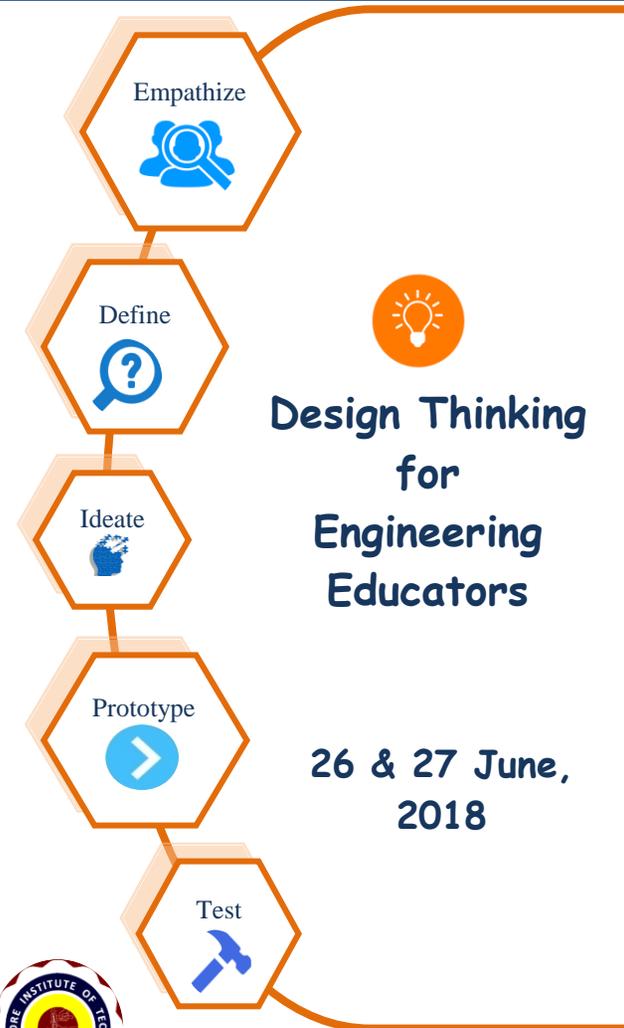
