## DETAILS OF COURSES

### 1. B.E. Degree

The duration of the Course is eight semesters. The first year is directed to a course in theoretical and practical understanding of basic mathematical, scientific and technological ideas, which are common to all the branches namely Civil, Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical and Electronics, Electronics and Communication & Computer Science and Engineering. The branch allocation is done in the first year itself through counselling. Each branch specialises in its own field while imbibing broad ideas from other branches. Intensive theoretical and practical coaching is given in each branch of study. Project works are encouraged systematically and extensively to train the students to apply the theoretical knowledge to practical problems.

### 2. B.Tech. Degree

#### (a) B.Tech. Chemical Engg.

The Course is of eight semesters duration leading to a degree in Chemical Engineering. The syllabus is both intensive and extensive with a perfect blend of topics from Unit Processes and Unit Operations considered as indispensable in many Chemical industries.

#### (b) B.Tech. Information Technology

The Information Technology Department admits students to an undergraduate program which guarantees rigorous and dedicated academic environment with a blend of both theoretical and practical problem solving skills. The course is of eight semester duration with systematically build up broad foundations and depth in selected intellectual theme areas that match student's individual interests viz., techniques of analysis, design, and experimentation in a variety of fields such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), Big data, Cloud computing, Internet of Things (IoT) etc.

#### (c) B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence & Data Science

This four year Bachelor course offers sound knowledge in the field of data, analytics, statistical, mathematical modelling, and computing sciences. The curriculum is designed to focus in producing quality and technologically advanced graduates by the end of the course. Apart from specific Artificial Intelligence and Data Science knowledge, the course also encompasses the basic and the well known key areas of Computer Science field. It is a well designed graduate course to uplift the engineering programs that matches the needs of industry.

### 3. M.E. Degree

The Institute offers M.E. Degree Courses in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electronics & Communications Engineering and Computer Science & Engineering branches. The course is of four semesters duration for Full-time and of six semesters for Part-time study. The specialisations in each discipline are given in the table :

#### 4. Ph.D. Degree

#### 5. Part-time B.E. Degree Courses in Civil, Mechanical and Electrical & Electronics Engineering.

The duration of these courses for the Engineering diploma holders, is seven semesters.

#### 6. Master of Computer Applications (M.C.A.)

The highly acclaimed M.C.A. programme prepares graduates in all significant areas of Computer Science. Special emphasis is given to all critical aspects of software development, in order to ensure that students of this programme can develop into full fledged software professionals. The programme is designed to prepare students for leadership positions in both technical and managerial careers in the software industry. Our curriculum supplements an adaptive syllabus and good infrastructure. There are three semesters of course work with a balanced mixture of theory and laboratory course. There are two projects: one mini project and one full term project in the sixth semester. The duration of the programme is two years. The M.C.A. course at CIT was accredited by NBA in the year 2016.

#### 7. M.Sc. Software Systems

This is a unique five-year integrated PG Programme specially designed for HSC students. The curriculum and syllabi are designed carefully, starting with the

fundamentals of computer science and gradually upgrading with core and electives relating to Software Engineering, Cloud, Mobile, Data Analytics and Information Systems in the subsequent semesters, moulding the students over the five years into competent software professionals.

### **8. M.Sc. Data Science**

The unique five year integrated programme in Data Science is designed to train the students in design and development of systems with scalable techniques for data analysis and decision making in data intensive fields. The designed curriculum is a perfect blend of theory, extensive laboratory practice and two full time project internships in IT/Research Organizations, which will make students to become industry ready data analysts

### **9. M.Sc. Decision and Computing Sciences**

The first of its kind unique five year integrated programme in M.Sc. Decision and Computing Sciences is designed to meet the growing demand of computationally proficient decision scientists. The curriculum and syllabi are designed meticulously to equip the students with strong fundamentals on statistics, data analysis, mathematical optimization, computer science, decision analysis, and business knowledge. The programme offers sound practical experience through extensive laboratory courses, minor project to develop decision tools, and two full-semester project internships in industry; which moulds students to become expert decision scientists to facilitate informed decision making in multiple functional areas of the organization.

### **10. M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning**

The five year integrated M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AI & ML) is a leading edge programme, designed with strong foundations in Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, AI & ML concepts. The programme provides good exposure to latest technologies, along with real time projects leading to creating AI&ML specialists who will have unique capabilities to design and develop intelligent software for challenging and critical problems across domains. A complete platform will be provided to nurture budding AI & ML engineers, capable of creating an impact in the world.

### **11. MBA**

The Department of Management Studies at CIT is established in the academic year 2021-22 with a vision to develop MBA graduates with multi-disciplinary skills and global outlook. The MBA program of CIT is designed such that the students gain exposure to theory and practice alike. The department aims at developing and empowering MBA graduates who possess Techno-Managerial skills. The department is offering specialization in the domains like Financial Management, Marketing Management, Human Resource Management, Operations Management, Information Systems Management and Business Analytics. - ii. A pass in HSC (Vocational Stream) with Engineering Vocational subjects and any one or two of related subjects (Maths, Physics and Chemistry)  
(OR)
- iii. Diploma in one of the Engineering Courses (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical or Electronics)  
(OR)
- iv. Any other Equivalent qualification approved by the State Board of Technical Education/Higher Secondary Board of Tamilnadu.

A candidate should have passed the B.E. Degree Examination in the respective branch of Engineering of Anna University or equivalent examination of any other University/Institution.

- **PH.D. PROGRAMMES IN CIVIL, MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONICS, ELECTRONICS & COMMUNICATION AND CHEMICAL ENGINEERING**

A candidate should have passed the M.E./M.Tech. Degree Examination in the concerned subject of the Anna University or any other examination equivalent thereto.

- **PART-TIME B.E. DEGREE IN CIVIL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING**

A pass in the diploma examination conducted by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu in the respective discipline of Engineering atleast two years before the last date prescribed for the submission of application or an equivalent examination. The place of working should not be at a distance more than **90 km** from the Institute to which admission is sought.

**Selection will be based on the following weightages :**

- i) Academic mark in the qualifying examination ... 75 %
- ii) For completed years after passing the qualifying exam ... 25%

(For every completed year of service 2 marks and for every completed year without service 1 mark)

## OVERDUE CHARGES

The borrowed book may be renewed for one more period, if no one has reserved the same. If a borrowed book or other material is not returned / renewed within the due date of return, an overdue charge of Rs. 0.50 per day will be charged.

When obtaining the 'clearance certificate' from the library, students have to pay the overdue charges pending in their account at the end of each semester.

## LOSS OF BOOKS

If a borrowed book is lost or damaged, the borrower is required to replace the same edition or the latest edition of the same book. If it is not done so, triple the cost of the latest edition of the book has to be remitted.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Complete silence is to be observed in the library.
- Speaking in mobile phone is totally prohibited inside the library.

## COMPUTING FACILITIES

The institute has state of the art computing facilities which include CAD/CAM lab, Computer Based Process Control, CFD Lab, Robotics and Cloud Computing Lab. Each department has a separate computer centre. The Computer facilities are used to the maximum extent to impart high quality training to Under Graduate and Post Graduate students and for research purposes. All the centres have internet access. There is also a separate CAD centre for Training & Consultancy franchised by Autodesk, California, USA.

## INTERNET

Internet facility with a bandwidth of 200 Mbps is available. Internet centre is kept open on all days with 60 seating capacity. Internet facility is also available in all the computer centres in the departments.

## OTHER FACILITIES

### ● Science of Creativity and Personality Development

A subject named "Science of Creativity and Personality Development" was introduced from the academic year 1988-89 for the students to maintain a sound physique and imbibe intellectual and moral values.

The following are the salient features of the new subject :

- a. Philosophy and purpose of life.
- b. Knowledge of the interaction among individuals, society and the world.

### ● Counselling System

Each student is assigned to the care of a faculty member called Tutor, who will be available for consultation and advice on all matters, academic and social. Tutor-Ward Meetings (TWM's) are held every week. The students are expected to meet the assigned tutors and discuss the progress and problems in studies and extra-curricular activities. All leave letters and other correspondence to the authorities should be forwarded through the tutors only. Class council meetings discuss the progress of the classes during the semester.

- **Intensive Coaching Scheme**

Weekly tests and assignments form part of this intensive coaching scheme. The academic progress and the attendance of the students are reviewed periodically. In addition, two mid-semester tests are conducted during each semester. Sessional marks are awarded on the basis of the performance in these tests, attendance and assignments.

- **Medical Facilities**

There is a Dispensary in the campus with a full-time Pharmacist. He is in charge of all the routine medical requirements. An experienced medical practitioner of the cadre of Civil Surgeon is attached to the Institute. He visits the Institute every Thursday and looks after the medical needs of the students. All students are required to undergo medical check-up every year.

- **Physical Education Facilities**

The College has the following facilities for playing games: Cricket, Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Hockey, Ballbadminton, Kabaddi, Kho-kho, Tennis, Table tennis, Chess, Carrom & Tennicoit. Besides, there is a big stadium with a 400m track & field for all the athletic events. Provisions are available for special training in gymnastics and body building. A course in Karate is conducted at the institute.

A Physical Director assisted by a Physical Training Instructor looks after the athletic activities. Every year internal tournaments are conducted, so as to enable the students to take active part in the sports & games. The Institute is also a member in Fit India & its activities. Further, the Institute enters various Inter Collegiate League and Knockout tournaments of the Coimbatore Inter Collegiate Athletic Association, CENTIES, COVAI TIES, and also the tournaments and sports conducted by the Coimbatore District Sports Club and Anna University.

- **Road Safety Patrol - RSP**

Road Safety Unit was initiated by Mr. Adeshar H Mulla (Retired Principal, B S Bardhan School, Mumbai) in 1957 with the motto of helping uncountable society in traffic regulation a correct discipline.

The Road Safety Patrol unit of the institution has been functioning since 2012. This unit under Tamilnadu police Traffic Wardens Organization, Coimbatore city. Students join RSP as a volunteer or as a parade cadet (both boys and girls). Volunteers are involved in Road Safety activities and assist traffic wardens to control traffic during peak days like Diwali and Konihaman cart festival etc. Cadets are trained to do parade during Independence Day and Republic Day in VOC ground and in the campus. It improves student's punctuality, discipline

and hones their leadership qualities. The main objective of RSP is to increase road safety awareness among the students and so as to improve road safety in society. The motto of Road Safety Patrol is “WE LIVE TO SERVE”.

● **National Service Scheme - NSS**

The National Service Scheme unit of the Institute has been functioning since 1977-78. There are four NSS units functioning in the Institute with 100 volunteers in each unit. They undertake community and rural development activities in and around Pachapalayam, Poorandampalayam, Molapalayam and Urumandan Gounden Pudur - the adopted villages of the Institute. These units concentrate on Adult Education Programmes, Health and Hygiene Campaigns etc. In addition to regular activities, summer camps are also conducted.

● **Youth Red Cross - YRC**

The Youth Red Cross Unit of the Institute has been functioning from the Academic year 2003 - 2004.

The YRC movement is based on the following three principles

- ❖ Protection of Health and Life
- ❖ Service to the Sick and Suffering
- ❖ Promotion of national and international friendship to develop the mental and moral capacities of the youth.

● **Placement and Training Cell**

The Institute has a Placement and Training Cell headed by a professor. The Cell interacts with leading industries, arranges for campus interviews and offers ample job opportunities to the final year students of different disciplines. Further, it takes effective steps to provide In-Plant Training to the undergraduate students with a view to prepare and acclimatize them to the industrial environment.

● **Industry - Institute Partnership Cell**

To act as liaison centres between industries and various departments of the Institute for activities which are mutually beneficial, an Industry Institute Partnership Cell is functioning in our Institute. It is sponsored by AICTE. The main objectives include co-ordination and promotion of consultancy services, promote sponsored and joint R&D projects, signing of MoU on behalf of the Institution and conduct training programmes for industrial personnel etc.

● **Students' Union**

To promote the cultural and social activities of the student body, a Students' Union is there in the Institute. The office bearers of the union are nominated by the Principal. The student who ranks first upto third year autonomous examination becomes the Chairperson of the Union and the student who ranks first upto second year examination becomes the Secretary.

Distinguished personalities from all walks of public life are invited to address the students on various topics of technical and general interest. Films of technical and social nature are often screened for the benefit of the students. The students union conducts, every year, an intramural cultural programme called 'NAKSHATRA' to tap the creative potential of the first & second year students of this Institute.

## HOSTEL

### ● **Management of the Hostel**

The General Management of the Hostel shall be vested with the Principal who is also the Chief Warden. He is assisted by the Dean - Student Affairs, Deputy Warden and Counsellors. The Deputy Warden looks after the day-to-day administration of Hostel with the help of the Hostel Office.

### ● **Gent's Hostel**

Gent's hostels can accommodate approximately 1200 students. Students are provided with rooms for double occupancy. Facilities like indoor Pool Game room, Table Tennis, Reading Room, T.V. Room, Gymnasium and Student Store are provided. Each block is having a Residential Tutor to interact with students to improve the cordial relationship between inmates and hostel authorities.

### ● **Ladies Hostel**

Ladies Hostels can accommodate approximately 800 students. Four-bedded and two-bedded spacious rooms are available. Facilities like indoor Games Room, Reading Room, T.V. Room, Sick Room, Visitor's Room, Students Store, Gymnasium are provided in the hostel block. Residential Matrons take care of the welfare of students and maintenance of discipline.

### ● **Student Counsellors**

In order to ensure smooth running of the Hostel and to establish a healthy staff-students relationship, counsellors are appointed by the Chief Warden. The Head of Departments of the different faculties of the Institute are the Counsellors. The students belonging to a particular discipline will be directly under the care of their respective Head of the Department. The students shall seek the advice and guidance of their counsellors, whenever they are confronted with difficulties or problems.

### ● **Hostel Committee**

The Hostel Committee shall be constituted at the beginning of every academic year. The Committee shall consist of the following members:

Principal & Chief Warden, Dean-Students Affairs, Deputy Wardens,  
Counsellors and Elected Representatives of the students.

The following office bearers are nominated at the beginning of the academic year.

General Secretary, Joint Secretaries, Reading Room Secretary,  
Mess Representatives, and TV Room Secretary

● **Duties and Responsibilities of the Members of the Hostel Committee.**

They shall assist the Warden and Deputy Warden in the following matters.

- a. Supervising the cooking and distribution of food.
- b. Preparation of the menu for the hostel mess.
- c. Ordering and purchasing of provisions for the mess.
- d. Checking the delivery of materials to ensure quality.
- e. Running the Reading Room and Library.
- f. Giving useful suggestions regarding the administration of the Hostel.
- g. To help in the maintenance of discipline in the hostel.

● **Mess and Mess Rules**

The hostel has both Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian messes. Every inmate of the hostel has to dine compulsorily in one of the two messes. These are run on dividing basis and the menu served shall be prepared and approved by the Hostel Committee. The mess month shall be reckoned from the 21st of a month to the 20th of next month.

● **Reduction Rules**

- i. Only those who will be out of station are eligible to apply for reduction. No inmate who has applied for reduction will be permitted to stay in the hostel room during the period for which reduction has been applied.
- ii. Application for reduction should be made at least two days in advance in the prescribed form available in the hostel office/with mess supervisor.  
The signature of the Tutor / Faculty member authorised by the department for this purpose should be obtained in the form prescribed before submission. The reduction application form can be handed over to the mess supervisor. In addition to this, appropriate entries should be made in the reduction register available in the mess.
- iii. Reduction will be given only when the period of absence is not less than 4 days. Full reduction will be given for (n-2) days where n-refers to the number of days for which reduction has been applied.

- 
- 
- iv. If any inmate who has applied for mess reduction is found staying in the hostel premises during the period for which reduction is claimed, he will forfeit the reduction for the entire period.
  - v. Students who have applied for reduction upto a certain period but are not able to rejoin on that date can get the period of reduction extended only by sending a letter, (seeking permission for the same) to the Deputy Warden, in advance. The students are advised to send such letters under certificate of posting.
  - vi. Under no circumstances, reduction can be claimed for the lapsed period.

#### ● Entertainment of Guests

- i. Members are permitted to entertain guests up to a limited number in each mess. The inmate entertaining the guest should bring his/her identity card (to establish his/her identity), make entries in the guest book in his/her own handwriting, get the duly filled in counterfoil and only then take the guest, inside the dining hall. The guest should always be accompanied by the host.
- ii. One inmate of the hostel is not permitted to entertain another inmate as guest in the mess under any circumstance.

#### ● Payment of Mess Charges

Mess bill for the month ending on 20th of the calendar month will be available at the end of that calendar month. The mess bill should be paid on or before the 15th of the following calendar month. A fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be collected for payments made between the 16th and the last working day of the calendar month. If the student has not paid the mess dues before the last working day of the calendar month, the student will not be permitted to dine in the mess till the payment is made (compulsory reduction period). Further re-admission fee of Rs. 250/- will be collected. If the dues are not paid before the end of the next calendar month (end of compulsory reduction period of one month duration), the student will be deemed to have vacated from the hostel and his/her accounts will be settled by the Hostel Office automatically. Such students will not be given accommodation in the hostel. Students who default in payment of mess bills for three occasions will not be given accommodation in the hostel for subsequent years.

---

- **Discipline and Disciplinary Action**

Every inmate of the Hostel is expected to maintain a high standard of discipline to keep up the good name of the hostel. Inmates should refrain from antisocial activities like consuming alcoholic beverages, intoxicating drugs, etc. Indulgence in serious offences such as mentioned above may result in their expulsion from the hostel. The Deputy Wardens and Counsellors shall decide on the course of disciplinary action to be taken against students involved in such offences. A student once expelled from the Hostel shall not be eligible to seek re-admission. No inmate is allowed to entertain any expelled student in the hostel.

- **Hostel Property**

Inmates are personally responsible for the electrical fittings in their room and for the maintenance and return of the furniture assigned to them in proper condition. They will be charged the cost of repairs for any damage done to the hostel property during the occupation of their room.

- **Hostel Servants**

Students should not demand any special service from Hostel servants. They should not rebuke or abuse any servant of the Hostel, but must report to the Deputy Warden any kind of misconduct or breach of duty on the part of the servants. The inmates should not pay tips to hostel servants.

- **Medical Facilities**

There is a Dispensary in the campus with a full-time Pharmacist. He is in charge of all the routine medical requirements. An experienced medical practitioner of the cadre of Civil Surgeon is attached to the Institute. He visits the Institute every Thursday and looks after the medical needs of the students. All students are required to undergo medical check-up every year.

- **Accommodation for Guests**

Normally, guests are not permitted to stay in the Hostel. However, guests with valid reasons, desirous of staying in the hostel room should get prior permission from the Deputy Warden. A nominal charge of Rs. 100/- per day will be levied for each of the guests permitted to stay in the hostel.

Separate Register for guests is maintained in the Hostel Office/Deputy Warden's Block. Proper entries should be made in the register before taking the guest to the room for their stay. No guest can stay for more than three days.

**No Female Guests are permitted under any circumstance in Gents hostel.**  
**No Male Guests are permitted under any circumstance in Ladies hostel.**

### ● Miscellaneous

The Warden reserves the right to put two or more students in a room.

Notices concerning the members of the Hostel shall be displayed on the Hostel Notice Boards. This shall be considered as sufficient notice to the students.

Notice of any kind other than those issued by the Warden shall require the prior approval of the Warden before they are circulated in the Hostel or put up on the Notice Board.

Any question not covered by the rules herein laid down shall be decided by the Wardens and Counsellors and duly reported to the Principal.

### ● TEQIP

Technical Education of Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) is established by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. Coimbatore Institute of Technology is proud to have TEQIP Phase II and Phase III as its credit. The main objectives of TEQIP are

- Strengthening Institutions to produce high quality engineers for better employability.
- Scaling-up postgraduate education and demand-driven Research & development and Innovation.
- Establishing Centers of Excellence for focused research.
- Training of faculty for effective Teaching.
- Enhancing Institutional and System Management effectiveness.
- Mentoring the Institution in the focus state.

### ● About AICTE – QIP – CIT

Quality Improvement Programme launched by the Government of India in the year 1970, is now being implemented and monitored by the National QIP Coordination Committee, funded through AICTE, Coimbatore Institute of Technology is one of the AICTE – QIP centers in India to offer Ph.D. Programme in the Engineering disciplines of Civil, Mechanical, EEE and Chemical. Also, it sponsors short term courses to upgrade the expertise and capabilities of the faculty members. So far CIT has conducted 41 programmes under this scheme.

## TLC

Coimbatore Institute of Technology (CIT) has been identified and approved to establish Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) by MHRD under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) scheme in December 2017. The vision of TLC is to achieve academic excellence in imparting teaching-learning techniques to faculty members of technical institutions.

CIT-TLC has chosen Academics, Research and Management as its core areas. The following are the functions of CIT-TLC:

- ❖ To prepare teaching learning material (handbooks, reference books, e-content, etc.)
- ❖ To prepare and share different schemes of assessment and evaluation methods
- ❖ To design the subject-specific curricular framework
- ❖ To organize workshops, Faculty development programs/Seminars on the themes of pedagogy and various discipline-specific topics
- ❖ To provide guidance and support to carry out research studies
- ❖ To publish articles related to teaching-learning and domain-specific research topics

From its inception in the year 2018 to till date, the Centre has served the training needs of around twelve thousand three hundred and fifty-eight teachers (12,358), research scholars & students pan India.

### **Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre (SPDP):**

The Institute has established the Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre (SPDC) as a central facility to conduct skill and personality development training for the reserved category students of our Institute. The SPDC is sponsored by AICTE under the scheme AICTE Quality Improvement Scheme (AQIS) during the year 2020-2021. This scheme aims to inculcate skill sets to enhance the employability prospects and mould them as successful professionals.

### **Center of Excellence in Cyber Security (CoE)**

As its next milestone, CIT-TLC has initiated a new vertical in the domain of cyber security. The centre has a new 20,400 sq. ft. building with centralized air conditioning facilities which is most appropriate to house the CoE in Cyber Security.

In-line with National Cyber Security Strategy 2020, CIT-TLC has established a “Center of Excellence” (CoE) in Cyber Security with the support of **TATA Consultancy Services (TCS) & Skills DA, Chennai** and in collaboration with **ISAC** for capacity building in the area of Cyber Security. The facility has training rooms, conference room and a simulator where trainees can participate in experiential learning. The cyber security CoE at CIT-TLC aims to act as a facilitator for capacity building and developing cyber security experts in the region.
