Intellina 2K25, a technical fest hosted by the department of Artificial Intelligence and Data Science of CIT, Coimbatore, was held during 4th and 5th of April, 2025. This propelled innovation, creativity and battle of technological prowess of like-minded Students from various institutions to new heights.

Inauguration:

The event began with a Big Bang held in the Auditorium in the presence of Dr. Valliappan Raman, Mr. Somasundaram and Col. Jacob Podipara with Mr. Selvaraaju Murugesan as the chief guest who is a prominent figure in the AI and data science community. Technical Events:
