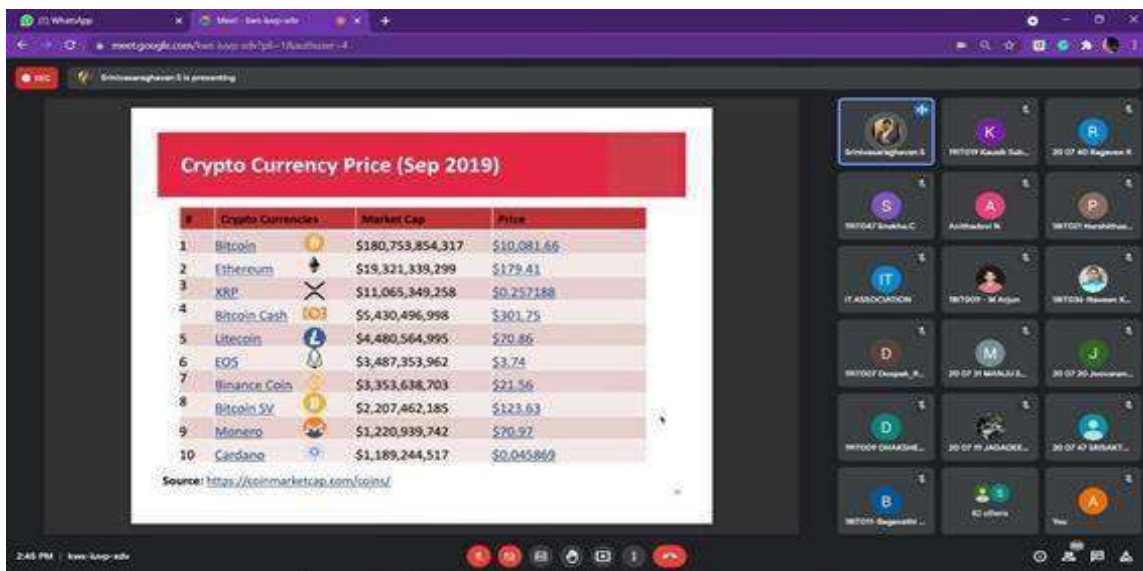
## **IMPACT OF BLOCK CHAIN REVOLUTION IN INDUSTRY**

Overall, the session was very interactive and insightful with attendees having valuable information to take back.

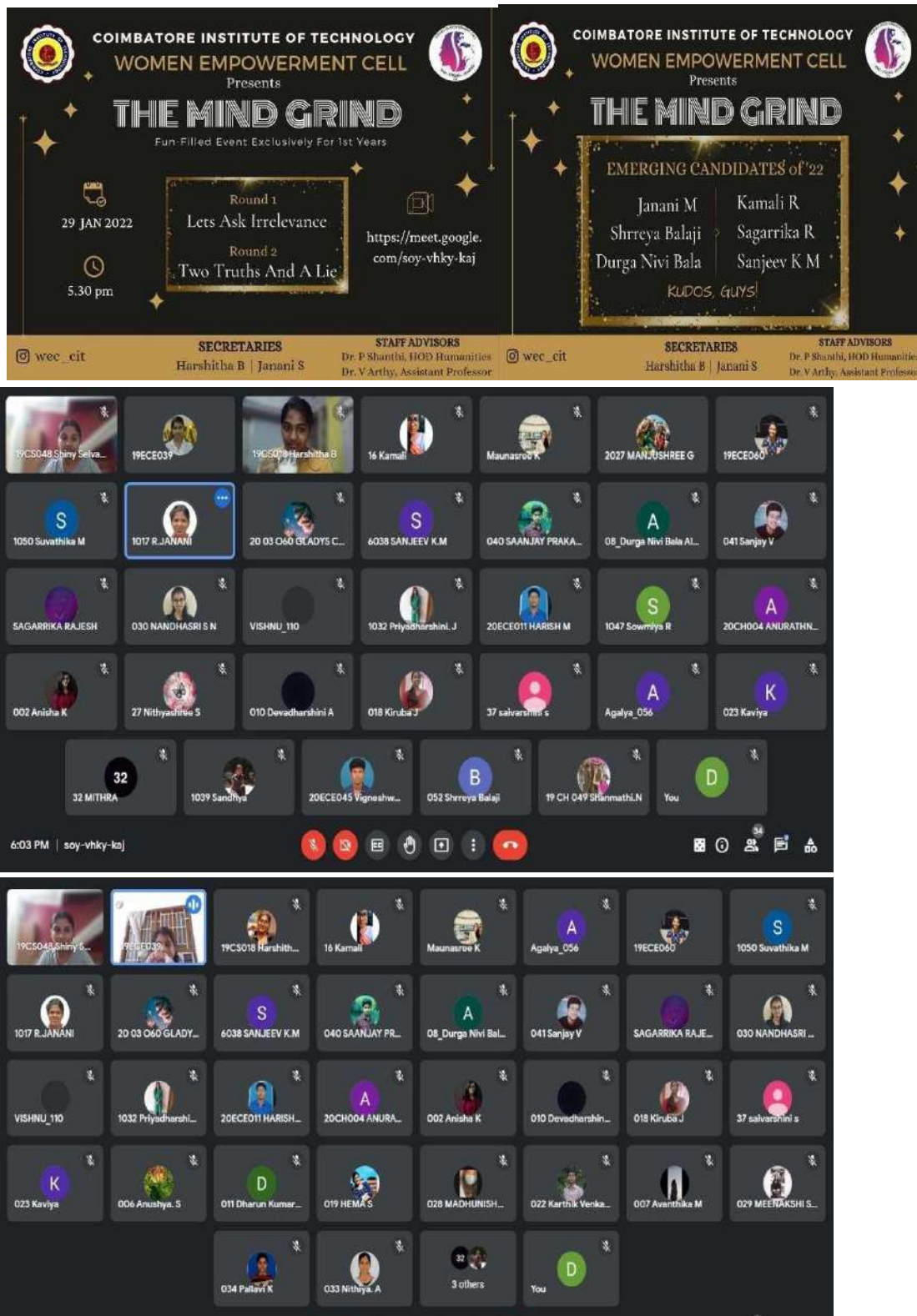
